

Based on recommended curriculum and teaching methodologies, our school has developed a vast database of tasks that each student has to learn to achieve the desired learning outcomes for preparation, execution, and tracking of customized development plans, we have deployed an effective, in-house developed digital tool (Lakshya: IEP) that enables all stakeholders (students, teachers, principal, trustees and parents) to play an active role in the development of each of our children.



Co-curricular Activities


Apart from school activities we also focus on various co-curricular activities like Music, Dance, Computers, indoor and outdoor sports. In the new school building we will also have a library room for our students.

Well Equipped Digitalized Classroom

Each of our classrooms will be 300 Sq.ft designed with good light and ventilation. Each class will have a Interactive Digital White board where the teachers can teach the students in an interactive way. Our students are very much interested in using the digital boards and most of them are very familiar with it.

Vocational Training Centre

The entire Vocational Training and Skill Development Centre is on the third floor of the building where we will be having a bakery unit, stitching unit and a computer unit. The idea is to empower our children through income-generating activities and help them become self-sufficient.



Toy Room




In the new school building we will have a toy cum library room. Where the students can spend time playing and reading books with their classmates.


Medical Room

It will be a well-equipped space to take care of any medical emergency arising within the school. Medical consumables, basic medicines and first aid box are always adequately available.

OT Room & Smart Environment

On the first floor of the building we have the Occupational Therapy Room (OT Room). The occupational therapist will assess children and recommend various activities for improvement. Last quarter we procured new items for the OT room such as rope bridge, ball pool, sensory mat, peg boards, lock chairs and over head pully.





Status of Building Construction

- New school building structure of ground floor + 3 floors is now ready.
- Internal plaster and gypsum work is nearly complete. In addition we have bought all the tiles required to complete the full work.
- Firefighting equipment installation work has commenced and expected to get completed by mid Sep 2023.
- Lifts will be delivered in Sep 2023 for installation.
- We are expecting the new school building to be ready by end of Oct 2023, after which the class fit-out work will commence. We expect the building to be ready for occupation by Jan 2024.

Stories from the Ground

Ved has Down Syndrome. When Ved joined Suryoday school he would avoid eye-contact and had very little interest in talking or reading. Be it maths – writing till 200 in figures or words, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division; be it language – reading two to three-letter words, usage of nouns, articles, genders, opposites, rhyming words, filling in the blanks, reading and writing small simple sentences – Ved has aced it all. However Ved has shown significant improvement since joining our school.

Ved is developing new skills. He has begun to use the computer, primarily MS Word. He can now type his full name and copy write an entire passage.



Shubham suffers from mild intellectual disability. He previously attended a regular Marathi medium school before enrolling in Suryoday School in 2019. He has been in the school for the past four years and was enrolled in the pre-vocational class, where he developed his mathematics, sequencing, and perception skills.

With the introduction of Sol's Arc course, we brought him back to train and improve his skills so that he could be placed in a better job.
