

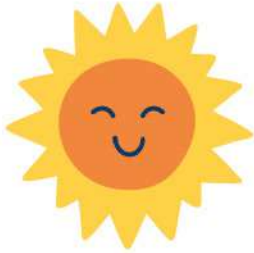


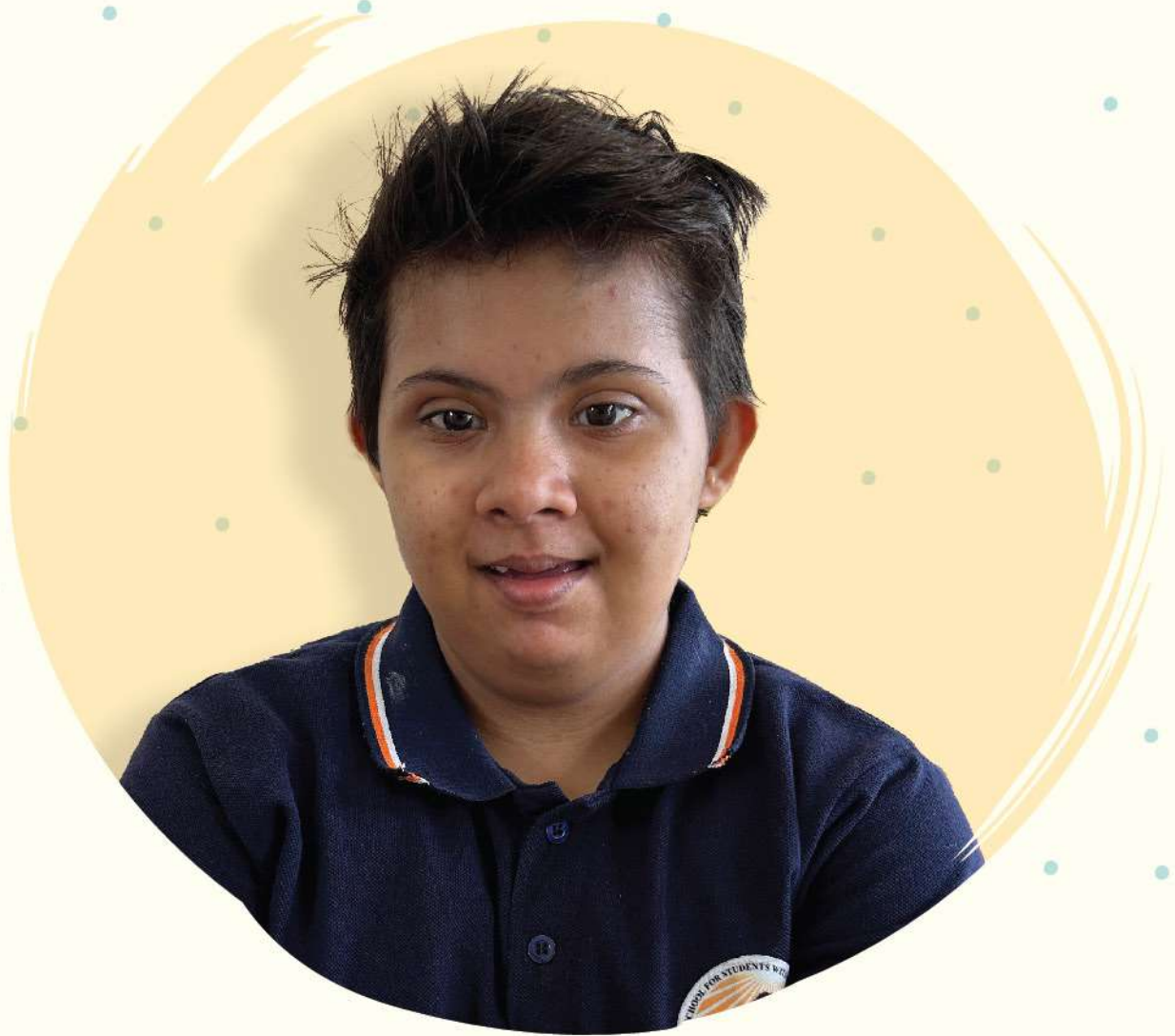

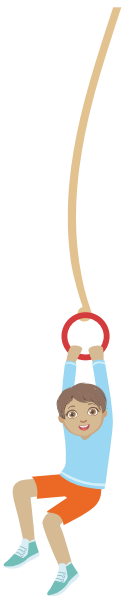


Our Vision

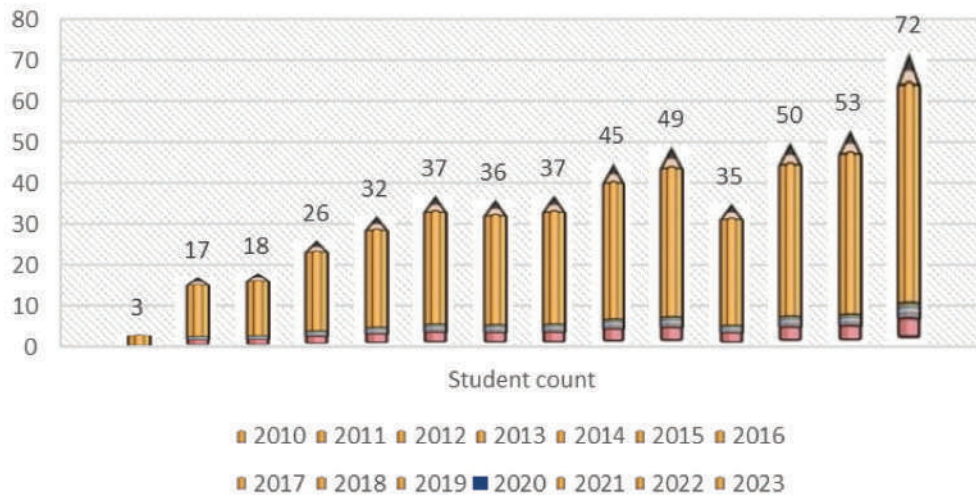

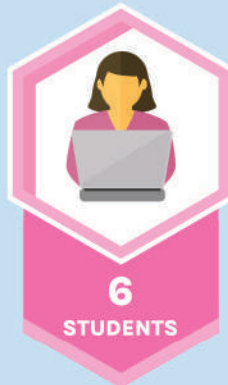

Completion of our New School Building



For the past 14 years, Suryoday Trust operated Suryoday Special School from 14 rented premises in Nalasopara. These modest beginnings were filled with hope and determination, where our dedicated special educators transformed lives within the confines of a limited space. As word spread about our programs, more families sought our help. Admissions grew, and with them, the challenges of space became glaringly evident.

Despite our best efforts, the rented facility could no longer accommodate the increasing number of children. We found ourselves turning away families. It was clear that to continue our mission, we needed a new home. Driven by this vision, our trustees embarked on a transformative journey: to build a disabled-friendly school that would cater to the unique needs of special children.

Overview of the Building

Ground Floor

Welcoming and inviting with wide and welcoming entrance, our ground floor is symbolic vision of opening doors of opportunities for all.

First Floor: Space theme

This floor focuses on Early Intervention, providing a foundation for our youngest learners. We have Early Intervention Classroom and a dedicated space for Occupational Therapy room to help children to learn and improve physical and motor related strengths.

Second Floor: Jungle theme

A vibrant hub for our Primary classes, blending academics with emotional and physical care. The second floor has Primary classes, medical room and an IQ Assessment cum Toy room for cognitive evaluation and play based learning.

Third Floor: City theme

A bridge between structural learning and real-world readiness. The third floor consists of 2 Pre-vocational and Vocational class with a hands-on practical lab for Baking, Sublimation printing and Candle making along with a computer training room.

Balance-Theme for 2023-24

Finding Balance In Every Step

At Suryoday Trust, we understand that balance is the cornerstone of growth for children with special needs. Whether it's balancing their physical health through therapeutic exercises, nurturing mental health through emotional support, or building life skills, balance is woven into the fabric of our programs.

Through lessons in structured classrooms, playful therapy sessions, and hands-on skill-building activities, we aim to provide a well-rounded development path for every child.

The theme of "Balance" resonates deeply with the holistic development approach at Suryoday RBL School. For children with special needs, achieving balance is not only about physical stability but also emotional, mental, and social well-being. By integrating this theme into core activities like Occupational Therapy (OT), Speech Therapy, Music, Dance, and Sports, the school fosters an environment where children can thrive in every aspect of their lives.



Occupational Therapy (OT)

Building Functional Balance

Balance plays a critical role in OT, where children are supported in developing motor coordination, sensory integration, and strength. Activities like walking on balance beams, seated exercises, and fine motor skill games help children achieve physical stability while improving their confidence. These exercises also promote cognitive balance, ensuring that motor and sensory development go hand in hand.



Speech Therapy

Communication and Emotional Balance

For children with speech delays or challenges, balance is about creating a bridge between clear communication and emotional regulation. Speech therapy sessions incorporate activities that focus on breath control, articulation, and rhythm, enabling students to develop clarity in their speech while feeling emotionally grounded. This balanced approach ensures that as children express themselves, they also develop self-esteem and social confidence.



Music

Harmonizing Emotions and Skills

Music therapy provides a perfect example of balance in action. Singing, playing instruments, or even rhythmic clapping helps children improve coordination, auditory processing, and emotional expression. Music becomes a tool to balance creativity and structure, fostering both joy and discipline in the lives of special needs children.



Dance

Merging Physical and Emotional Balance

Dance combines physical movement with emotional release, making it a powerful tool for fostering balance. For children with special needs, dance therapy improves body awareness, motor skills, and social interaction. Whether it's practicing simple rhythmic movements or participating in group choreography, dance helps create a balance between physical control and emotional freedom.



Sports

Developing Resilience and Coordination

Sports activities like running, yoga, and adaptive games promote balance by enhancing physical agility, teamwork, and resilience. Sports practices also encourage a sense of belonging, balancing competition with collaboration.

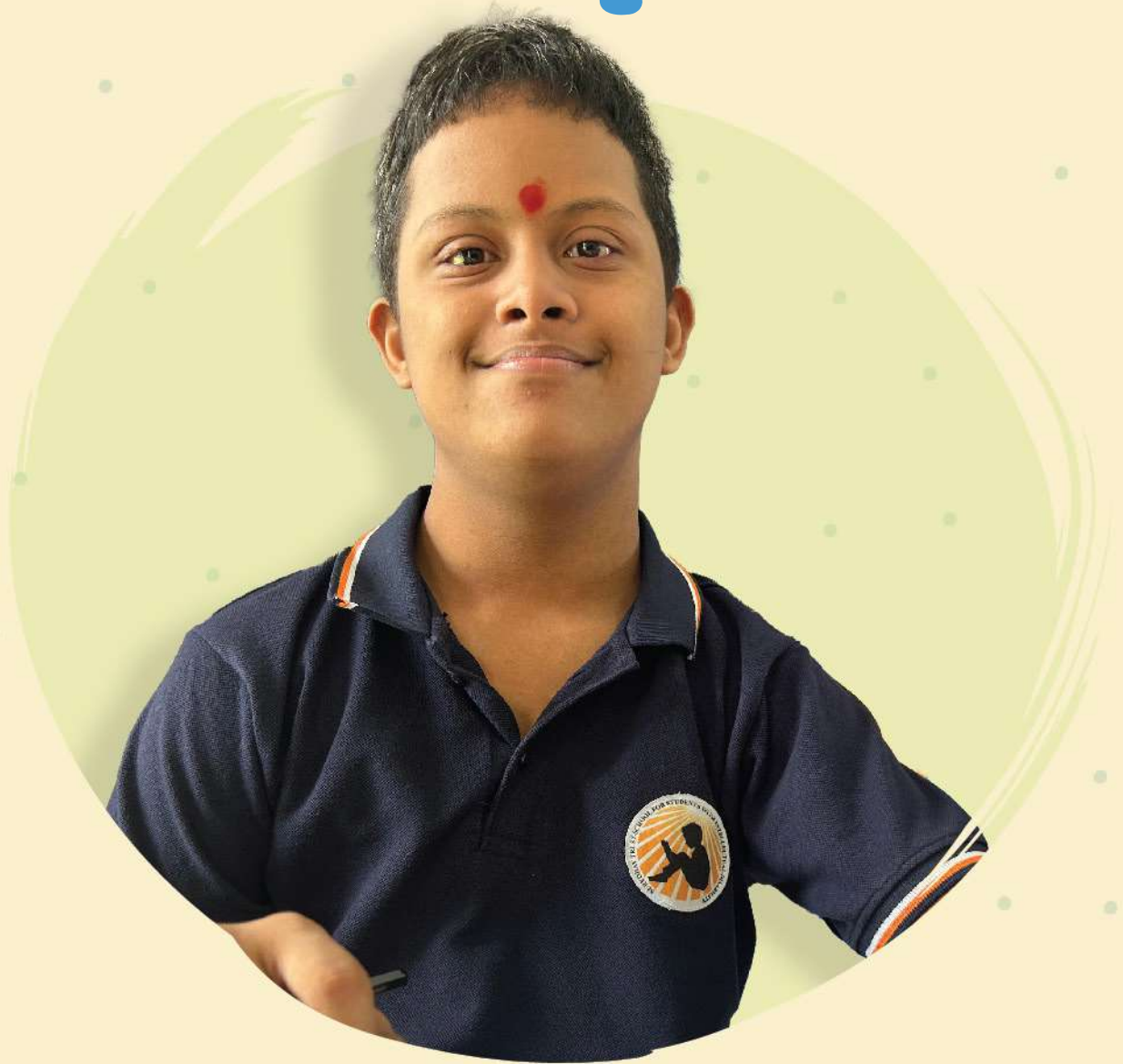


Introduction to Yoga Sessions

Mr. Gauri Shankar's regular presence for the sessions adds a personal touch to the initiative, fostering a consistent and supportive environment.





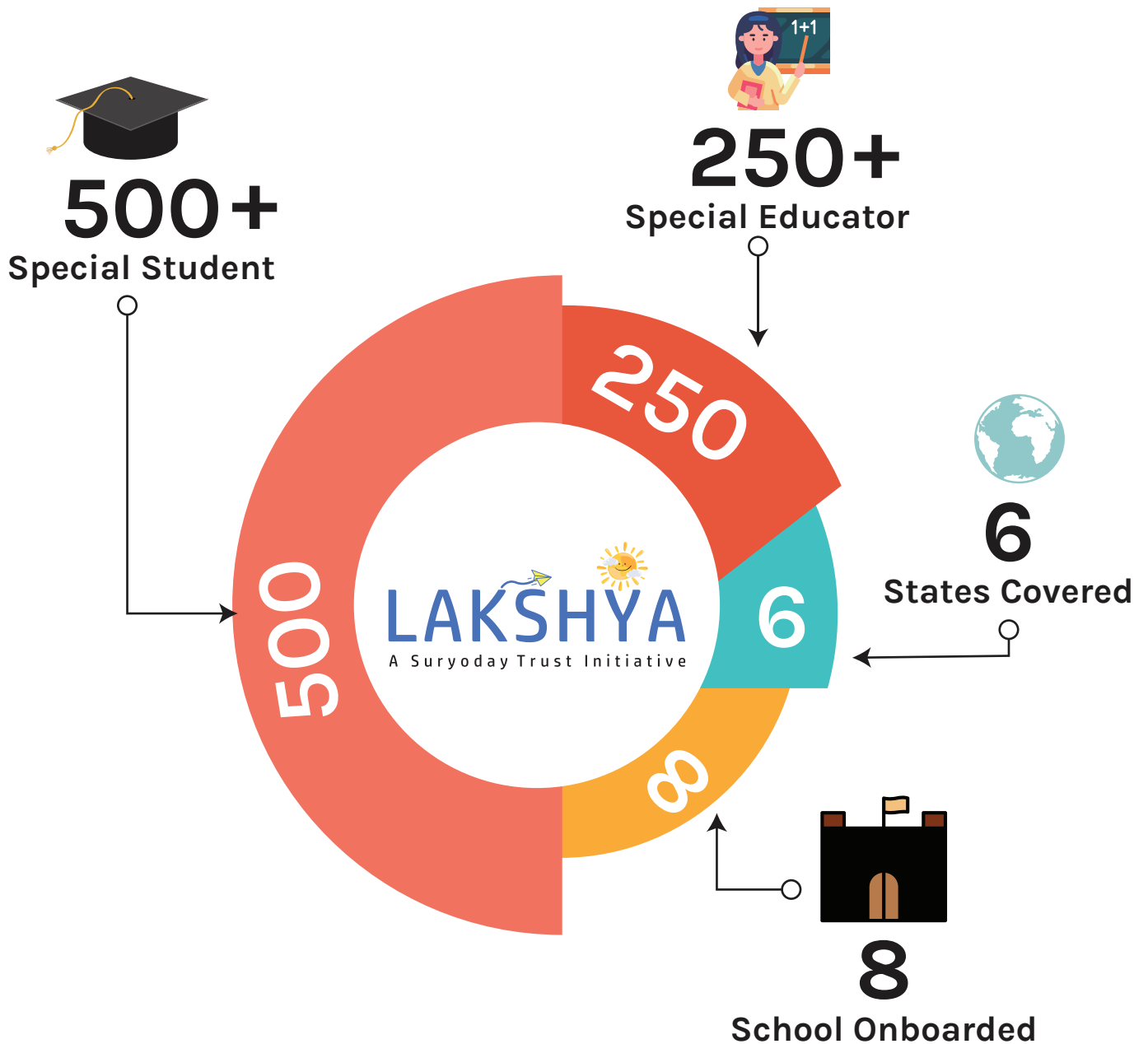

Vocational Training and Skill Development

In January 2023, we started with Vocational Training and Skill Development Centre in Vasai At Suryoday Trust, we empower young adults with special needs to achieve financial independence through vocational training and skill development. Our centre focuses on equipping students with practical skills, enabling them to secure employment and lead self-reliant lives.

Expansion of Project Pragati

New Bhayander Centre

In January 2024, a new centre was opened in Bhayander East for young adults aged 14 and above. The centre offers Pre-Vocational Training and Vocational training courses in Art and Craft, Stitching, Embroidery and Sublimation for adults with Intellectual Disabilities.

Through Project Pragati, high-quality, market-ready products are created with the guidance of professional designers and artisans. This initiative aims to establish a steady income stream for individuals with intellectual disabilities, helping them to thrive in mainstream markets.



Path to Financial Independence

Around 14 students, guided by their teachers, put in a lot of effort and time to create beautiful rakhis for sale. We are proud of our students who were involved in preparing rakhis for the Raksha Bandhan celebration.

Suryoday Trust arranged a corporate stall to display handmade rakhis and received an enormous response from the corporate connects, trustees, donors, and volunteers. To motivate and reward the students for their efforts and achievements, they were given monetary incentives as a bonus. Our teachers encouraged the students to continue honing their skills in Rakhi making and potentially pursue a career in related fields.

E-Commerce Success Story of Sonali Ghosh

Sonali joined Suryoday Trust as a young girl with mild intellectual disabilities, hesitant and shy, struggling with confidence and communication. Through the nurturing environment provided by the Trust, she gradually began to blossom. Engaging in activities like arts, crafts, and drama helped her express herself, while group programs encouraged her to step out of her comfort zone and build her social skills. With time, Sonali's personality began to shine as she developed a newfound confidence and eagerness to learn.

As she advanced through the pre-vocational and vocational programs, Sonali gained practical life skills, from baking and candle-making to computer training. She excelled in a Retail E-Commerce Program that equipped her with workplace-ready knowledge. An internship at Amazon allowed her to apply her skills in a real-world setting, where she impressed her mentors with her dedication and adaptability. Today, Sonali is employed at Amazon's warehouse, a shining example of what can be achieved through resilience, hard work, and the right support system.
